Jon Dee Graham, a native of Quemado, Texas, is an accomplished songwriter, vocalist and guitarist. At the age of 38 -- 25 years after he joined his first band in Del Rio, Texas -- Graham released his debut solo album, "Escape from Monster Island." In 2000, Jon Dee Graham was named the *Singer/Songwriter of the Year* at the Austin Music Awards and currently is on tour playing the rock music he's loved since he first started strumming the guitar. HOUSTON MARCHMAN

Houston Marchman, a Dallas native, mixes the sounds of country, Texas folk, polka, conjunto and blues into his music. His first full-length album, "Leavin' Dallas," has been charted on the Gavin Americana chart. With the release of his latest album, "Desperate Man," Marchman is broadening his audience without straying from his roots. Marchman is currently touring Texas.



DELBERT MCCLINTON

Delbert McClinton, a native of Lubbock, Texas, is a singer, songwriter, guitarist and harmonica player and has been a solo artist since 1962. McClinton has produced a number of popular songs, and in 1992, he won a Grammy Award for *Best Rock Vocal* for the duet he recorded with country/rock musician Bonnie Raitt titled "Good Man, Good Woman." His latest album, "Room to Breathe," was released in 2002 and debuted at No. 1 on the Billboard Blues Album Chart. In addition, the readers of *BluesWax*, a blues music publication, recently selected "Room to Breathe" as *Blues Album of the Year*.
