Owner-breeder Abercrombie writes country music single

Josephine Abercrombie, owner of Pin Oak Farm near Versailles, Kentucky, has worn many hats in a distinguished career as a horsewoman, skier, philanthropist, boxing promoter, and most recently as a country music songwriter.

Abercrombie, in partnership with her cousin, composer Michael Clay, wrote the ballad "Lonely's Only Me," which has been recorded by rising country singer Kristy Lee on a private record label in Dallas.

The share of Abercrombie's proceeds from the sale of the CD single will be donated to benefit not-for-profit children's charitable organizations.
