PARTNERSHIPS: Since its inception in September 2002, more than 30 music and arts organizations have joined the Texas Music Project to support its mission of strengthening and restoring music education in Texas schools. The principal organizations, led by the Social Marketing Resource Center, include the Texas Music Educators Association, the Texas Coalition for Quality Arts Education and the Texas Commission on the Arts. These groups work together forming the Texas Music Project to create meaningful music education programs for Texas schools, implement the “Don’t Mess With Texas Music™” public awareness campaign and create unique fundraising initiatives.

SOCIAL MARKETING RESOURCE CENTER: The Social Marketing Resource Center is a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization committed to providing unique marketing solutions to non-profit groups, as well as corporate non-profit initiatives. The Social Marketing Resource Center conceived the Texas Music Project, created the unique non-profit alliance, and currently functions as the overall project leader, including marketing, local community capacity and fundraising for the initiative.

TEXAS COALITION FOR QUALITY ARTS EDUCATION: The Texas Coalition for Quality Arts Education is a statewide, nonprofit service organization. The coalition includes more than 30 arts and education organizations throughout the state, including Texas Music Educators Association, Texas Coalition for Music Education, Texas Alliance for Education and the Arts and Texans for the Arts.
